ELECTRONIC DEVICE

POLICY

According to School Board Rules, the use of electronic devices by students in all Miami-Dade County Public Schools is strictly prohibited. The following policy will be in effect for all students during the 2009-2010 school year for all Miami Killian Senior High School students:

- ◆ Use of electronic devices such as MP3 Players (iPods) and their earphones will not be tolerated on school grounds.

- ◆ Cellular telephones will remain in the **OFF** position and put away where they cannot be seen when the student is on school grounds.

Any electronic device, earphone or cellular telephone confiscated by the Miami Killian Senior staff will be turned over to the Principal.

Confiscated items will only be returned to a parent or legal guardian after a conference is held with the Principal. There will be a 24 hour waiting period to obtain your confiscated electronic device. Items confiscated for a second time within a single school year will be kept until the end of the school year.
